How do I join the library?

It's free to join and you can use your library card in any Solihull library. Call into any library and show one form of identification that has your name and address on it. If you are under 13 a parent or guardian must sign the form and act as guarantor before you can borrow any items.

Suitable ID documents

- * your driving licence
- * your council tax payment form or your rent book
- * your medical card
- * a recent bill with your address from a utility provider such as a telephone or gas company

All documents must have your name and address.

Borrowing & Renewing Books

Borrow books for up to 28 days, up to 12 books (adult) 8 books (children). Also borrow up to 6 sound recordings for 2 weeks, *CDs and DVDs incur a low charge. (*not available in all libraries)

You can extend the loan period of your library books by telephone or online at www.solihull.gov.uk/libraries. You can borrow items from any library in Solihull and return items to any library. You can also use the mobile library service. Search the online catalogue at any time to see what books the library has available. Any book can be requested from any library (at a small charge). Staff will be happy to assist.

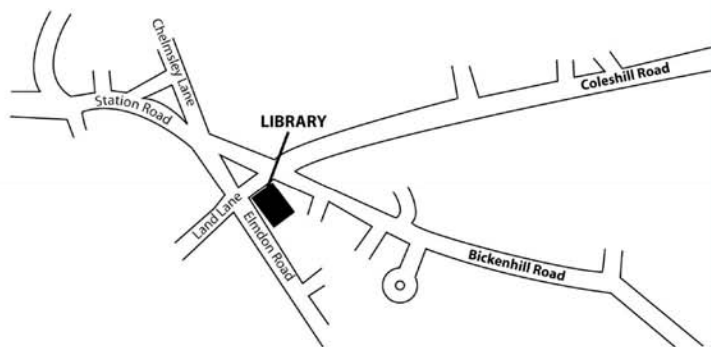
